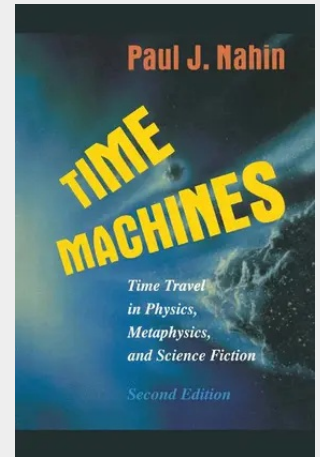


Time Machines
