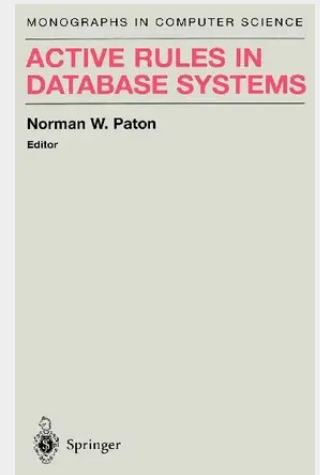


Active Rules in Database Systems
