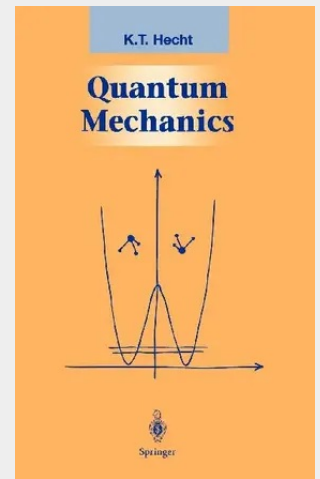


Quantum Mechanics
