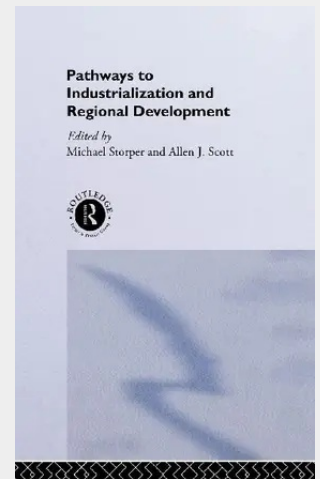


Pathways to Industrialization and Regional Development
