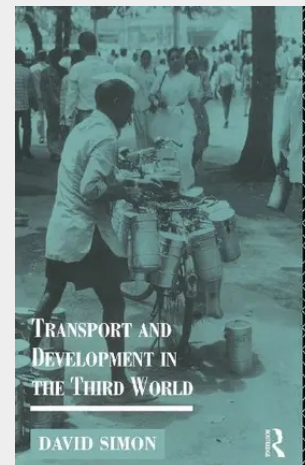


Transport and Development in the Third World
