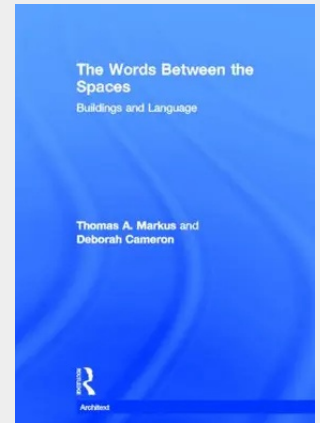


The Words Between the Spaces
