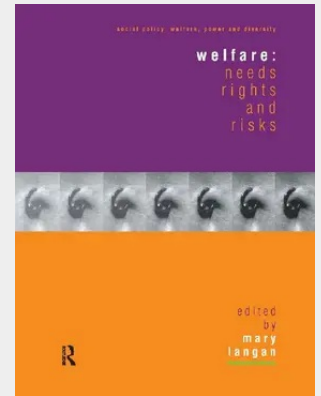


Welfare
