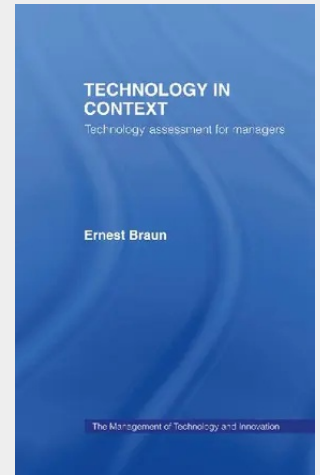


Technology in Context

Technology Assessment for Managers
