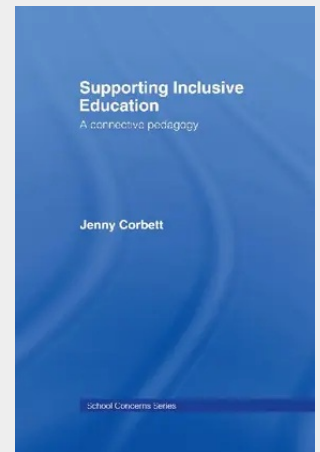


Supporting Inclusive Education
