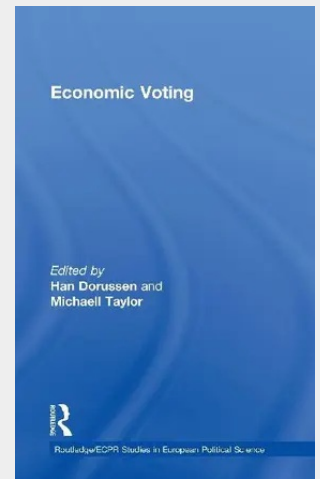


## Economic Voting
