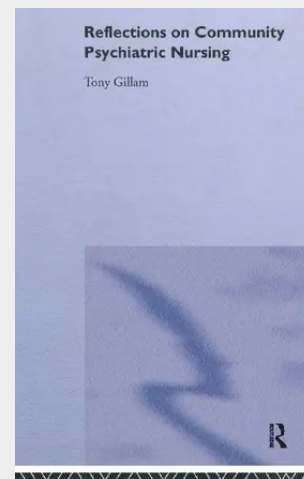


Reflections on Community Psychiatric Nursing
