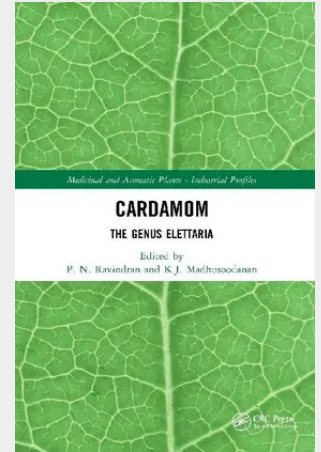


Cardamom
