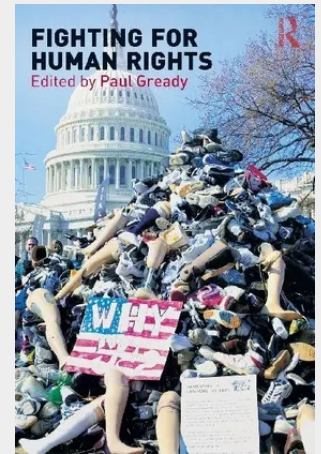


Fighting for Human Rights
