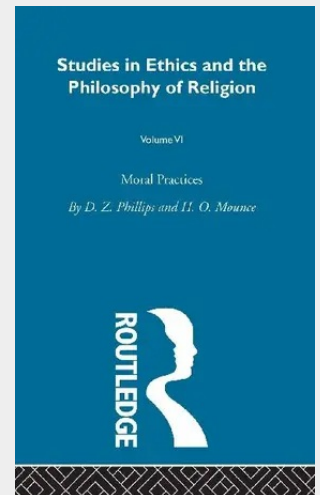


Moral Practices Vol 6
