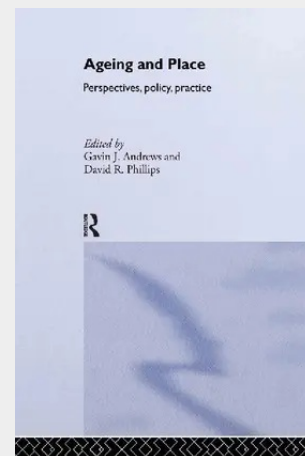


Ageing and Place
