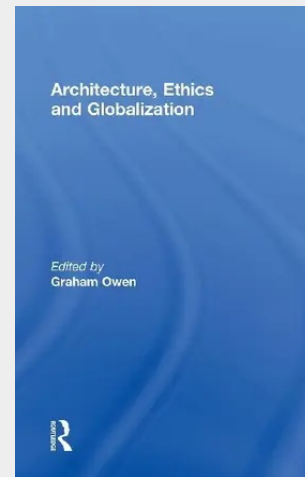


Architecture, Ethics and Globalization
