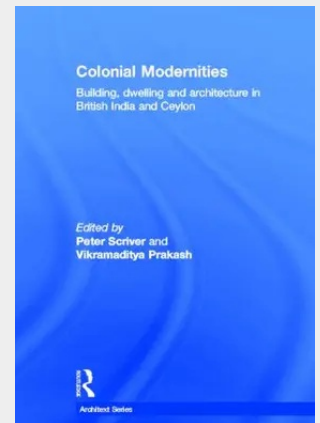


Colonial Modernities
