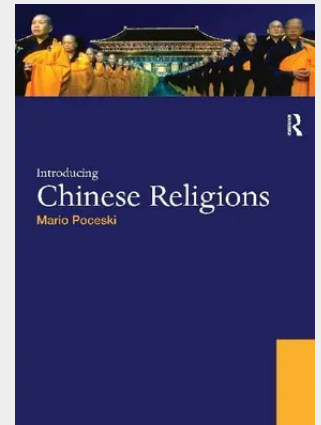


Introducing Chinese Religions
