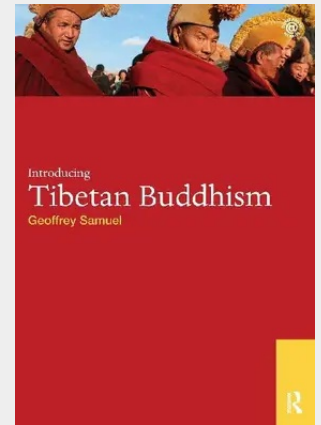


Introducing Tibetan Buddhism
