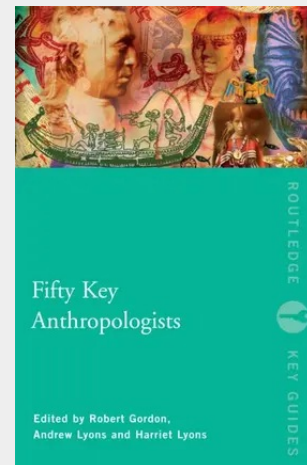


Fifty Key Anthropologists
