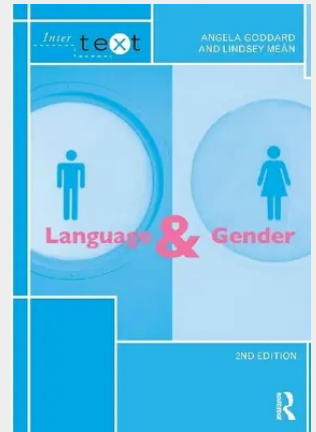


Language and Gender
