

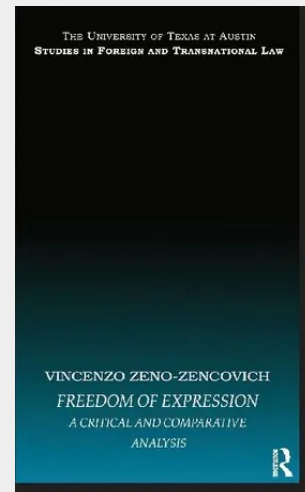
Zeno-Zencovich
