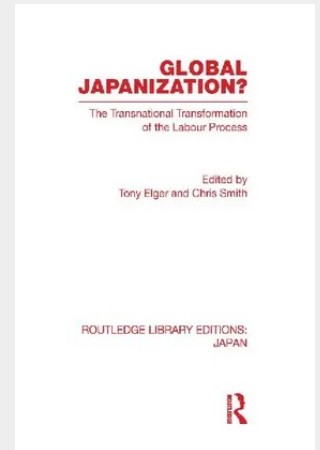


Global Japanization?
