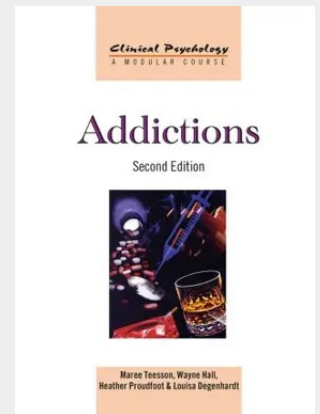


Addictions
