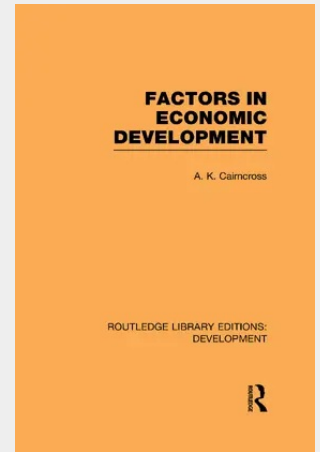


Cairncross
