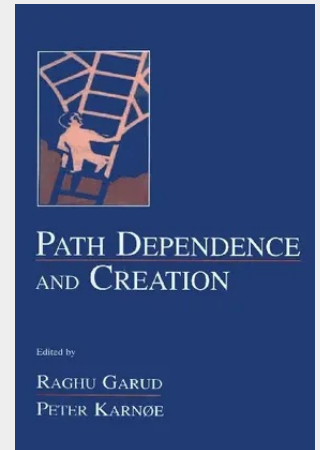


Path Dependence and Creation
