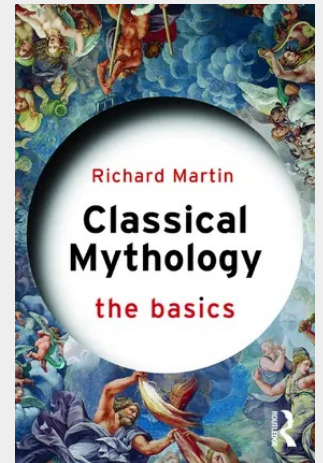


Classical Mythology: The Basics
