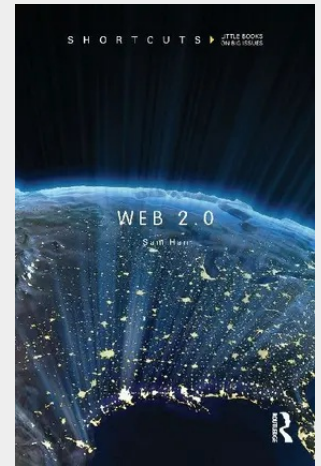


Web 2.0
