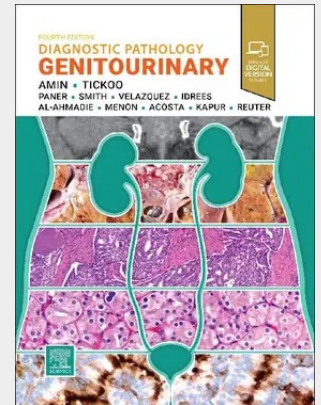


Diagnostic Pathology: Genitourinary
