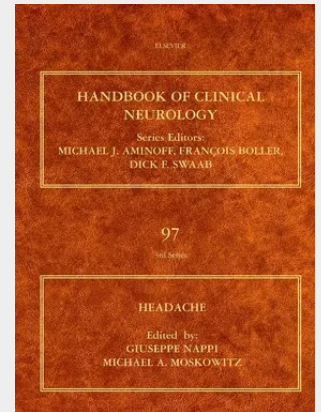

Handbook of Clinical Neurology: Headache covers various aspects of headaches. With this, significant advances in basic and applied brain sciences have emerged in the field of headache-related problems. It also deals with headache-related issues, such as pathogenic (chronobiological, endocrinological, and neuroimaging correlates), nosographic (i.e., migraine, vertigo, and headache in children), and treatment-related issues. The book will serve as a reference for researchers, clinical physicians, and other readers who want additional knowledge about the clinical features of headaches.



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
