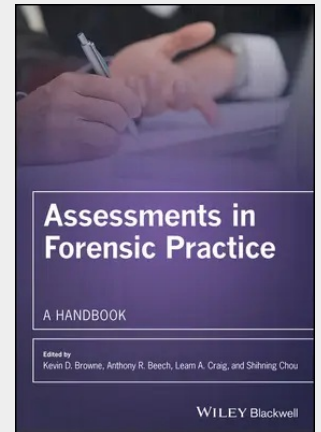


Assessments in Forensic Practice

Assessments in Forensic Practice: A Handbook provides practical guidance in the assessment of the most frequently encountered offender subgroups found within the criminal justice system. Topics include: - criminal justice assessments - offenders with mental disorders - family violence - policy and practice

The book is divided into four parts: Criminal Justice Assessments; Offenders with Mental Disorders; Family Violence; and Policy and Practice. Criminal Justice Assessments covers approaches to risk assessment and assessment techniques for different subgroups of offenders, while Offenders with Mental Disorders focuses on special groups of offenders. Family Violence examines child abuse and domestic violence and Policy and Practice looks at behavioural science support in police investigations, the ethical implications of risk assessment and the psychologist as expert witness.



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
