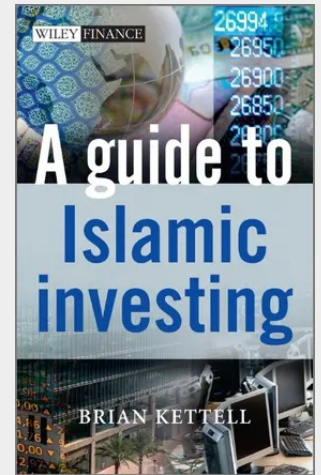


Guide to Islamic Investing
