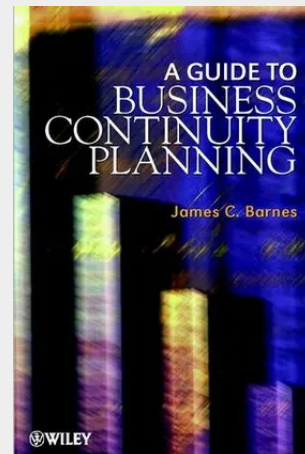


A Guide to Business Continuity Planning
