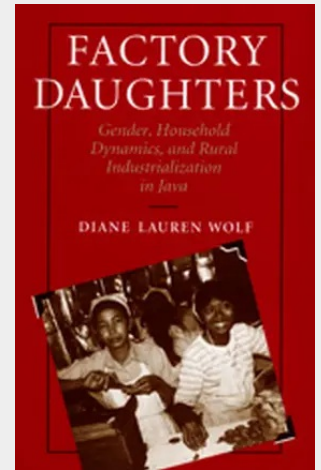


Factory Daughters
