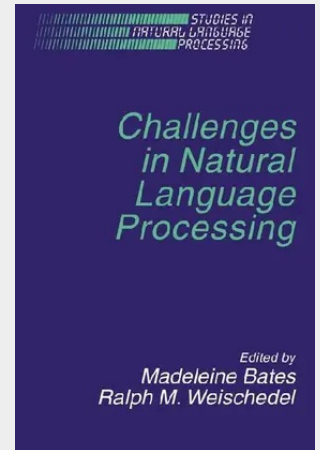


Challenges in Natural Language
