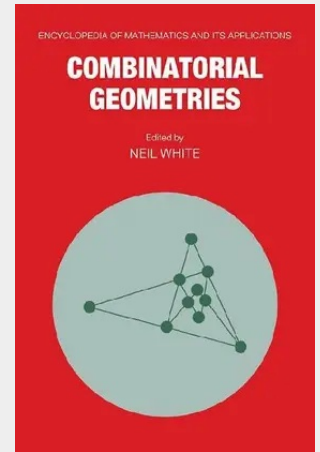


## Combinatorial Geometries
