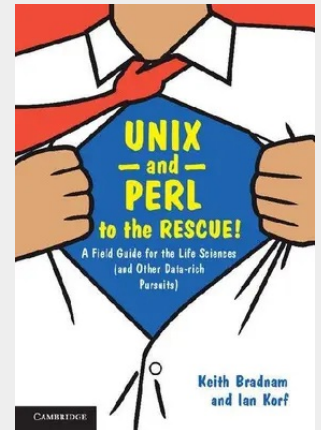


UNIX and Perl to the Rescue!
