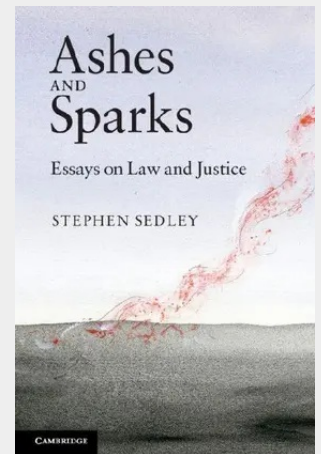


Ashes and Sparks
