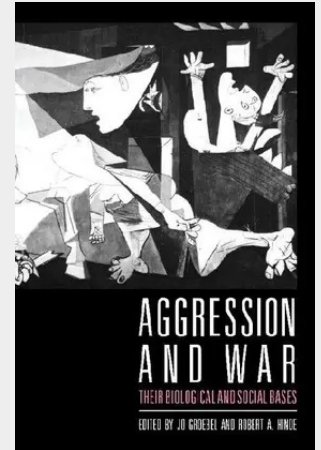


Aggression and War
