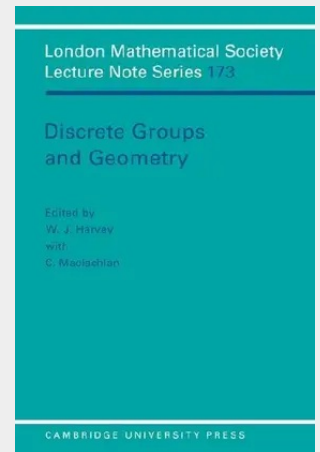


Discrete Groups and Geometry
