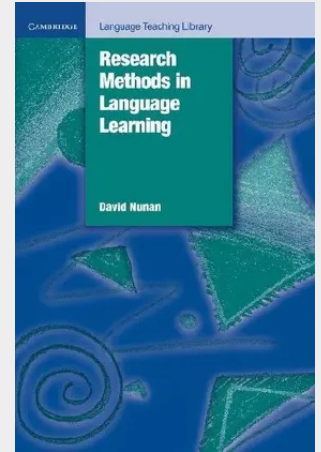


Research Methods in Language Learning
