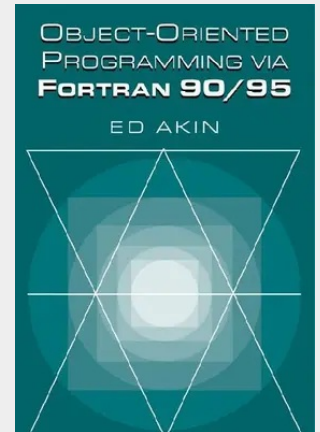


Object-Oriented Programming Via FORTRAN 90/95
