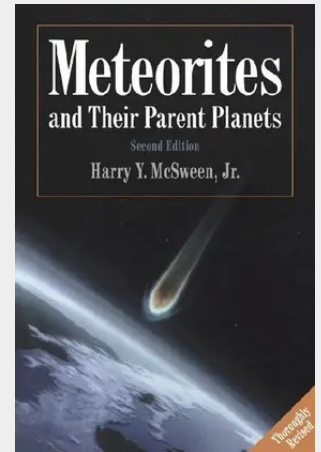


## Meteorites and Their Parent Planets
