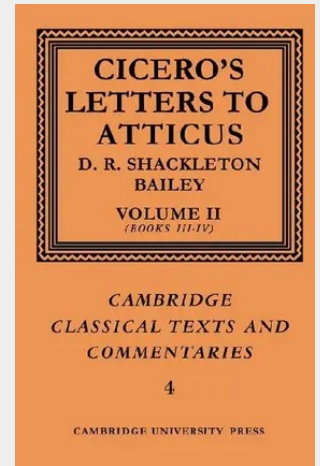


Cicero
