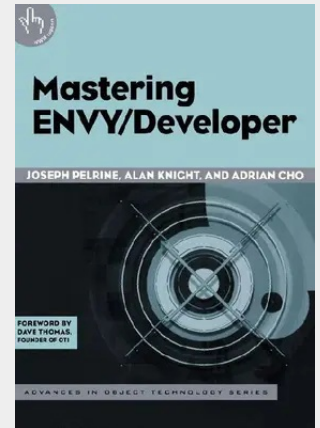


Mastering ENVY/Developer
