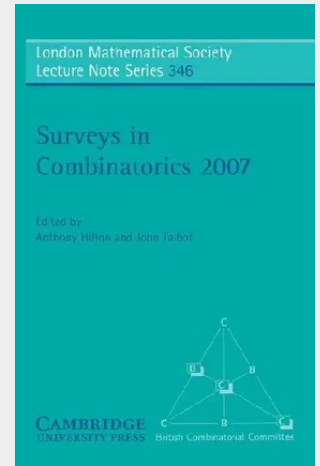


Surveys in Combinatorics 2007
