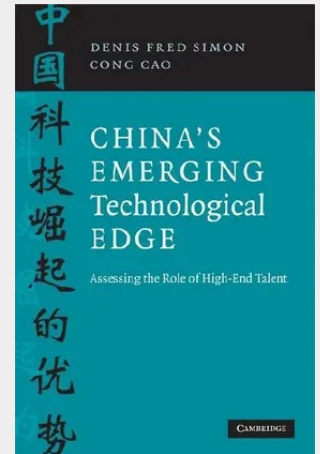


China's Emerging Technological Edge
