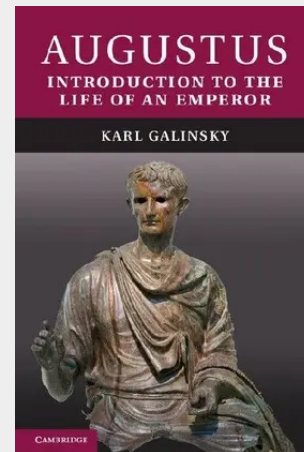


Augustus
