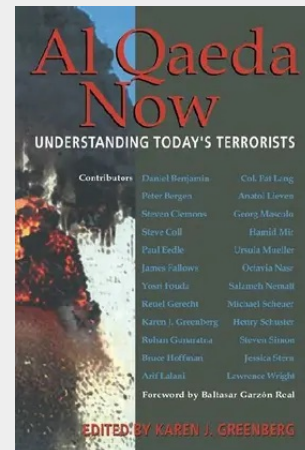


Al Qaeda Now
