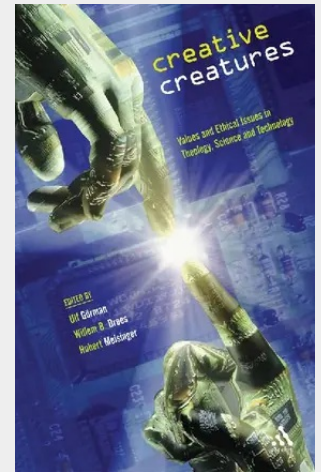


Creative Creatures
